6-Day Summer Excursion For People with Disabilities

The summer holidays are just a breath away! However, there is a belief that if you are a person with disability, this may seem beyond your dreams. In fact, there are plenty of possibilities for any person with a disability to enjoy sun, sea and sports holidays all around Europe.

ENAT aims to make European tourism destinations, products and services accessible to all travellers. More specifically, the European Network for Accessible Tourism involves many aspects: a) bringing together sector actors to share their experience, b) promoting wider awareness and understanding of the need for accessibility in all areas of travel and tourism throughout Europe c) supporting the development and spread of good policies and practices d) working to develop knowledge and expertise on accessibility issues in the European tourism field e) providing a platform for those who support accessibility in tourism.

ENAT acts as a representative voice towards European and national institutions and organisations whose actions have a direct influence on the tourism sector.

This summer a small group of Greek ENAT Members are organising an excursion, specially designed for people with disabilities. The programme of the excursion includes numerous activities such as horse-riding, going for a row in the lake, driving jeeps in the mountains, visiting famous monuments, entering and strolling with their wheelchair a well-known cave, and sightseeing.

The excursion, from 7 – 12 August, takes place in the region of Serres, and gives a great example that all are able to get pleasure from summer holidays. The only restriction one can find is willingness and not disability.
